Trailer Inspection Check - If Connected To Vehicle - 6

Is the tow hook nut tight?	
Chains - WSS, gate facing down?	
Brake Hitch - Locked down, R clip in?	
Breakaway cable attached, Pin inserted firmly to trailer?	
Trailer Plug firmly home?	
Brake & Indicator lights are in working order?	
Tyres (80 PSI) correct. Use pressure gauge?	
Load on wheel down & secure?	
Everything is secured and tied down?
